## DAC-EPOC Task Team on Climate Change and Development Co-operation

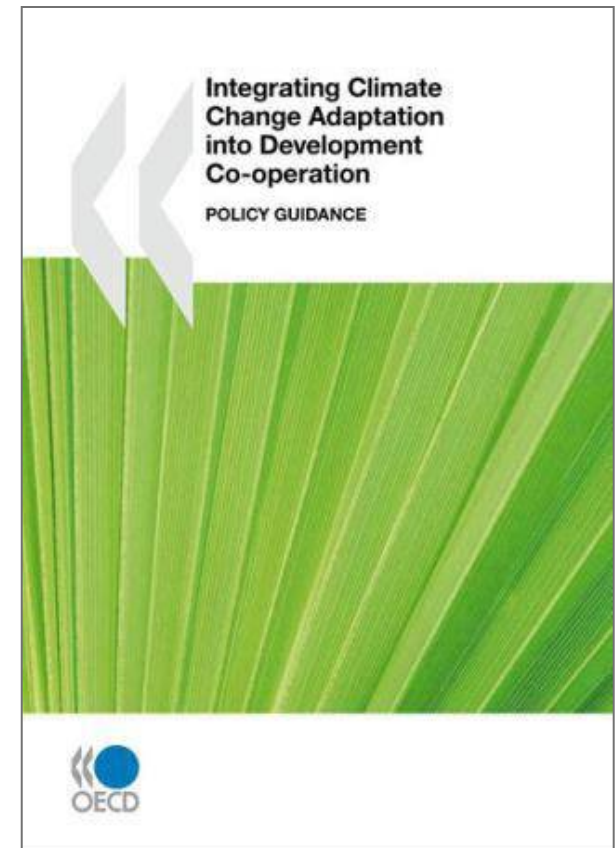

- An **OECD Task Team on Climate Change and Development Co-operation** - under Development Assistance Committee (DAC) and Environmental Policy Committee (EPOC), established in 2006
- A group of development co-operation and environment practitioners specialised on climate change adaptation
- The Task Team has worked on the **integration of climate change adaptation into development co-operation**, including:
  - The integration within existing aid modalities and environmental assessment processes in development co-operation



# The Task Team focus on Development Co-operation and Adaptation

- Policy Guidance on *Integrating Climate Change Adaptation into Development Co-operation* (2009)
  - Tools for development co-operation, environment ministries and agencies
- Exchange of knowledge amongst development cooperation partners on experience – exploring what is good practice in different contexts
- Current work on **monitoring & evaluation of adaptation**
